8:30am (Departure)	Optional Tour: Hoover Dam Depart from: North Entry – Tropicana Hotel & Casino <i>Hoover Dam, originally known as Boulder Dam, is a concrete arch-gravity dam in the Black Canyon of the Colorado River. It was constructed between 1931 and 1936. The tour today (at your own cost) will include a tour of the power plant and dam passageways within the dam itself. The tour lasts about an hour, and requires over a mile of walking on concrete or similar hard surfaces.</i>
